Annex A

Late Filing

Natural Health Trends Corp. (the "Company") has yet to finalize its financial statements for the quarter ended March 31, 2006. Accordingly, the Company can not file its Quarterly Report on Form 10-Q within 45 days following of the quarter end without unreasonable effort or expense.

Significant Change in Results of Operations

It is anticipated that there will be a significant change in the Company's results of operations for the quarter ended March 31, 2006 compared to its results of operations for the quarter ended March 31, 2005.

It is expected that net sales were approximately \$39.5 million for the three months ended March 31, 2006 compared to \$42.8 million for the three months

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ended March 31, 2005, a decrease of approximately \$3.3 million or 8 percent. The revenue decrease for the first three months of 2006 over the same period a year ago was primarily due to the sale of the Company's 51% equity interest in KGC Networks ("KGC"), which recorded \$8.4 million in the quarter ended March 31, 2005. Excluding KGC, sales were up 15%. This increase can be attributed to growth in the Hong Kong-based business, South Korea, and the opening of the Japan and Mexico offices.
