On November 10, 2006, we entered into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Tactical Vehicle Systems Division of Armor Holdings, Inc. s Aerospace and Defense Group, formerly known as Stewart & Stevenson Tactical Vehicle Systems LP, whereby we agreed to negotiate a subcontract agreement for automotive integration and final assembly of two hundred variants of the Cougar vehicle.
