- (2) Received in exchange for 60,000 shares of Infinity Discovery, Inc. ("IPI") common stock in connection with the merger of IPI into Infinity Pharmaceuticals, Inc. (the "Merger") based on a conversion ratio of 0.88411.
The option vests as to 9,375 of the shares on the first anniversary of the grant date, which grant date was September 12, 2006, and the
- (3) remainder in quarterly installments of 2,343 shares beginning at the end of the first quarter thereafter, provided that the holder continues to serve as a director.
- (4) The option vests as to 552 shares on June 12, 2006, 184 shares on June 30, 2006 and the remainder in equal monthly installments through February 2007.
- (5) Received in the Merger in exchange for a stock option to acquire 10,000 shares of IPI common stock for \$0.77 per share based on a conversion ratio of 0.88411.
