On March 4, 2005, Vicuron Pharmaceuticals, Inc. (the Company) issued a press release after receiving another milestone payment from Novartis Pharma AG (Novartis). The full text of the press release is attached as Exhibit 99.1 to this Current Report.

On March 4, 2005, the Company announced that it has received another milestone payment from Novartis in recognition of follow-up lead product candidates identified for Novartis development from its ongoing research collaboration focused on peptide deformylase inhibitors, a novel class of antibiotics. The Company also announced that Novartis suspended Phase I development of the first lead product candidate from the outpatient respiratory tract program in favor of developing a second lead compound, which is expected to enter the clinic by the end of the year.
