Excludes a total of 3,375,000 shares of Class B common stock held by Union Bank as trustee for certain GRATs and other irrevocable trusts for which a wholly owned subsidiary of the issuer has been designated to serve as investment advisor with investment power with respect to the assets held by the trusts and voting power with respect to shares of stock held by the trusts. The reporting person disclaims beneficial ownership of the shares discussed above except to the extent that the reporting person actually has or shares voting power or investment power with respect to such shares, and the reporting thereof shall not be construed as an admission that the reporting person is a beneficial owner of such shares.
